- ✓ We treat everyone fairly and without prejudice or discrimination and challenge discrimination when we see it.
- ✓ We respect each other's opinions, beliefs, lifestyles and choices even if they are different from our own.
- ✓ We are mindful and respectful of other people's physical and emotional boundaries.
- ✓ We speak and behave in a way that is based on mutual respect.
- ✓ We all play a part in keeping the centre clean and tidy.
- ✓ This is a drug and alcohol free centre. Please do not come in if you are under the influence of alcohol/illegal drugs, or bring any into the centre. Be mindful of other people's recovery.
- ✓ If you are feeling unhappy about something, or are concerned about someone else at Back on Track, please speak to a member of staff.
- ✓ If you are not able to work within this agreement we might ask you to take some time away from the centre or leave Back on Track. If this happens we will provide follow up support where we can.
- ✓ This agreement applies whenever we are together, whether we are in the centre or out and about.
